



## **Buffalo Trace Council Bankruptcy Update**

July 1, 2022

There is recent progress and related information to share regarding the national bankruptcy, as well as the local sale of Old Ben Scout Reservation.

### **Top questions related to OBSR**

#### 1) Is OBSR sold?

Yes, the property has been sold to Clint and Michelle Swisher, from the Bloomington, IN area. The property changed hands in early June.

### 2) What is the timeline for continuing to use OBSR?

The buyer has not set a timeline as of this announcement for when they will be accepting guests on their property. They have indicated their desire for our families and units to utilize their facilities when they open. We will await their press releases or other statements about their future plans with the property.

### 3) With the sale of the property, are there plans for relocation of programming?

Over the last few months, council volunteers have visited several facilities in Gibson, Spencer, and Warrick counties, evaluating the properties to develop workable plans for various types of events. The prospective buyer of OBSR has also indicated an interest in making the facility available to Scouts for future events.

## 4) What will happen to the sale proceeds?

Our first priority will be to pay our Council's portion of the national bankruptcy settlement. Additional decisions related to funds (remaining after the bankruptcy payment) will be reviewed by Council leadership. Some of the funds may be used to help offset costs with events that have to change locations. We also know that some funds will be necessary to support the transfer of retained program assets (from OBSR) to storage and maintenance at the Eykamp Scout Center. All decisions of this scope are made by the local council Board of Directors and not the national organization.

## Top questions related to national bankruptcy

## Is the bankruptcy close to closing? What still needs to happen to allow resolution?

The Bankruptcy Court completed the confirmation hearing in late April. We are still awaiting a decision from the Bankruptcy Court. These hearings, if successful, are the final stage of the bankruptcy legal proceedings. We are hopeful for full agreement of the Proposed Plan of Reorganization submitted by the National Council, as more than 85% of abuse survivors have approved the Plan. While national media coverage has not been extensive due to other events, you can find ongoing updates via Google News. Additionally, more information and updates about the restructuring are available via the national organization's dedicated restructuring website, www.BSArestructuring.org.

## **BALOO**

BALOO is a fun, exciting and required training for all those in your Pack who are in charge of conducting a Pack family campout. It is recommended that each Pack have at least two BALOO trained adults.

What is BALOO?

BALOO stands for Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation. It's designed to introduce Cub Scout leaders to the opportunities for pack overnight camping.

This is an energetic training that will cover everything you need to know to plan and run a pack overnighter. It's more than just camping—it includes ideas for outdoor activities, games and ceremonies; information on selecting and using camping equipment; how to run a campfire program; and hands-on Cub Scout & Webelos cooking demonstrations! In short, everything you need to know to make your pack overnighter a fun, successful event!

Why do I need BALOO?

BSA has made several changes to the camping policy for Tigers, Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts. Besides participating in council camps (day camp, resident camp), packs may now organize overnight campouts for boys and their families. Adults leading a pack overnighter must attend BALOO training.


